

In Memory of Michael Lill **1959 -2018**

We are deeply saddened by the loss of Michael Lill, MD, on June 19, 2018, after a long struggle with cancer. Dr. Lill was a brilliant and caring physician and a great supporter of the CIBMTR.

Director of the Blood and Marrow Transplant Program at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles, CA, Dr. Lill's research and clinical interests focused on stem cell transplantation, leukemia, lymphoma, myeloma, and MDS. He had a long-standing interest in the ethical and philosophical aspects of religion and its intersection with medical practice, and he provided bloodless transplantation for Jehovah's Witnesses.



Dr. Lill served on the CIBMTR Advisory Committee as well as several Working Committees. He published numerous peer-reviewed manuscripts and supported a variety of projects. His contributions to the field will be remembered. His humor and compassion will be missed.

Michael is survived by his wife, Gay, and children, Georgia and Alexander; other family members and friends; and a multitude of colleagues and patients across the HCT field. We extend our deepest sympathies to his family and loved ones.
