Reporting Cause of Death for Recipients with COVID-19

Recipient Death

Reporting accurate cause of death data is important to investigating the variables that are associated with post-infusion outcomes related to **COVID-19**. As a reminder, in any recipient where COVID-19 was believed to contribute to the patient's death (primary or contributing), COVID-19 should be reported among the causes of death. These data are actively used for analyses and other reporting purposes and should be **reported as soon as possible** after the recipient has died.

Reporting Death for Recipients on the TED Track

Report recipient death on the Post-TED (Form 2450). The date of death should be reported as the date of contact regardless of the time until the ideal date of contact. Do not complete the Recipient Death Data (Form 2900) for this track.

Reporting Death for Recipients on the Comprehensive Report Form (CRF) Follow-up Track and the Cellular Therapy Track

If "dead" is reported as the current survival status at the date of last contact on the Post-HCT Data (Form 2100) or the Cellular Therapy Essential Data Follow-Up (Form 4100) at the 100 day, six month and yearly time points, complete the Recipient Death Data (Form 2900) as soon as possible after the recipient has died.
