## How to do a Forms Manual Search



CIBMTR Forms Manuals are uploaded in (PDF) format to [CIBMTR.org](#), which makes them searchable. (1) Open the PDF of choice (2) Hit CTRL Shift - F (3) Type keywords into the search box that comes up, such as: *Question 15*. The results will display below. If several choices appear, you can click on them to see which answer meets your needs. Using this search function eliminates scrolling and could help you find what you want faster.
