


Reporting CT Infusions

Reporting to CIBMTR has always followed the same calendar driven schedule: 100 days, 6 months, and yearly post-infusion. This reporting strategy allows for observational reporting. Centers are becoming more interesting in reporting cellular therapy infusions “in real time”. There is a mechanism to allow this- the ‘create indication form’ button. If the CRID belongs to your site and you are interested in reporting a cell therapy infusion prior to the HCT form being due, you can create a new indication form, select ‘cellular therapy’ and make a F4000 due. It is important to note that the cell therapy infusion date must also be reported on the appropriate HCT follow up form when it comes due. A duplicate F4000 will not come due as long as the dates match.
