Field Experience Evaluation

Final Site Visit

- ◆ Student can explain the basic duties assigned in the Field Experience period
- ◆ Student has demonstrated personal and professional skills required as part of the Field Experience
- ◆ Student can describe the company's mission, culture, procedures, and products
- ◆ Student has established an acceptable work record
- ◆ Student has described the benefits of the internship to enhancing personal and professional skills
- ◆ Student has applied this Field Experience to further confirm or modify career choice
